## General Rules for All Exhibitors

1. Every exhibitor at the Warren Fair MUST hold a current membership for the Warren Agricultural Society. Annual membership fee is \$5.00 for adults 18 years and older. Youth under 18 years do not pay a membership.
2. Next year's membership fee of \$5.00 will be retained from prize money earned in Open classes.
3. A \$5.00 entry fee will be charged for exhibitors in the OPEN classes. There is no entry fee for youth entries.
4. Exhibitor numbers are assigned at time of membership purchase.
5. Ensure all exhibit information is entered correctly on the registration form **and** entry tag.
6. Registration forms and entry tags can be picked up from the fair secretary and/or the event chairperson.
7. Only one entry per exhibitor per section is allowed.
8. The judges' decisions are final.
9. Any grievances should be directed to the President of the Warren Agricultural Society, in writing before 3 pm on show day.
10. Committee has the authority to refuse entry of any bird or livestock showing signs of infectious disease.

## **CLASS R - Poultry**

Entry fee: \$2.00 per entry

To complete the entry form, list the class, breed, variety – cock, hen, cockerel, pullet etc.  
Ribbons only to be awarded.

### Section

1. Large Chickens – i.e.- American, Asiatic, English and other standard breeds
2. Bantam Chickens – i.e.- Modern Game, Game Single Comb, Clean Legged, Rose Comb etc.
3. Ducks – heavy, medium, light
4. Geese – heavy, medium, light
5. Turkeys
6. Guinea Fowl
7. Laying Hen display – at least 2 hens of the same breed
8. Meat pen – at least 2 or more of same breed

## **CLASS S – Rabbits**

Entry fee: \$2.00 per entry

Ribbons only to be awarded.

### Section

1. Fancy – Holland Lop, Netherland Dwarf, Mini Rex etc.
2. Utility – California, Giant chinchilla, Flemish Giant etc.
3. Pet – not purebred

## **CLASS T – Sheep (Dairy, Meat or Commercial)**

Entry fee - \$2.00 per entry

All animals should be on grounds by 9 am

Show begins at 9:30 am

All animals must be properly tethered or penned. (limited pens are available – first come only)

Exhibitors are responsible for any damage, injuries or liabilities caused by their livestock.

All sheep must have C.S.I.P identification tags in their ears upon arrival.

Must be shown in halter/harness if the exhibitor is under 12 years of age.

All meat breeds should be shorn 2 weeks prior to show

All livestock must be clean, healthy and well-groomed or be subject to disqualification.

Clean, neat attire is recommended for all exhibitors.

### **Prize Money**

#### **Sections 1 and 2:**

**1<sup>st</sup> - \$10      2<sup>nd</sup> - \$8      3<sup>rd</sup> - \$5**

#### **Market Lamb Class;**

**1<sup>st</sup> - \$12      2<sup>nd</sup> - \$10      3<sup>rd</sup> - \$8**

#### Section

1. Ram, ewe or wether (under one year of age)
2. Ram or ewe over one year
3. Champion Sheep – rosette only
4. Market Lamb – ram, ewe or wether less than 1 year of age
5. Junior Showmanship – open to exhibitors 12 years of age and younger
6. Senior Showmanship – open to exhibitors 13 years of age and older

## **CLASS U – Goat – (Dairy, Miniature, Meat or Fibre)**

Entry fee - \$2.00 per entry

All animals should be on grounds by 9 am

Show begins at 11:30 am

All animals must be properly tethered or penned. (limited pens are available – first come only)

Exhibitors are responsible for any damage, injuries or liabilities caused by their livestock.

All goats to be shown with collar unless otherwise specified.

All livestock must be clean, healthy and well-groomed or be subject to disqualification.

Clean, neat attire is recommended for all exhibitors.

### **Prize Money**

#### **Sections 1, 2 and 3:**

**1<sup>st</sup> - \$10                      2<sup>nd</sup> - \$8                      3<sup>rd</sup> - \$5**

#### Sections

1. Kid under one year
2. Doe – over one year
3. Milking Doe – any age
4. Best uddered doe
5. Champion Goat chosen from among all placing first in #1,2 & 3 (rosette only)
6. Junior Showmanship – open to exhibitors 12 years and under
7. Senior Showmanship – open to exhibitors 13 years and over

## **CLASS V     Lead and Wool Class**

This class is to promote wool/mohair and present the livestock in an attractive manner.  
Exhibitor must wear at least one article of wool/mohair clothing.  
The animal must be washed/clean and properly groomed.  
All livestock are to be on a halter/collar/harness and lead at all times.  
Contestants will be judged on their presentation and handling of their animal as well as on their appearance and how well they promote the fibre of their animal.

### **Prize Money:**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Trophy & \$25                      2<sup>nd</sup> - \$20                      3<sup>rd</sup> - \$15**

## **CLASS W – Cattle**

Entry fee - \$2.00 per entry  
All animals should be on grounds by 9 am  
Show begins at 10 am  
All animals must be properly tethered or penned.  
Exhibitors are responsible for any damage, injuries or liabilities caused by their livestock.  
All livestock must be clean, healthy and well-groomed or be subject to disqualification.  
Clean, neat attire is recommended for all exhibitors.

### **Prize Money:**

**1<sup>st</sup> - \$10.00                      2<sup>nd</sup> - \$8.00                      3<sup>rd</sup> - \$5.00**

### Sections

#### **Beef** - all beef breeds/crosses & dairy steers

1. Calf – under 6 months of age (open classes)
2. 6+ months to 2 years old (open)
3. 2+ years to mature cows (open)

#### **Dairy** – heifers and cows only

1. Calves – 6 months & under
2. 6 months to 2 years old – not in milk (open)
3. 2 year old heifers to mature cows in milk (open)

Junior Open Breed class for exhibitors under 12 if there are 4 or more in that age category

Grand Championship – Anne Spaul Trophy & Plaque

First place winners of all classes to determine the Grand Champion  
(name on plaque + trophy & ribbon)

Reserve Champion – ribbon

Honourable mention - ribbon

## **CLASS X – Barnyard Chuckle**

Open to any farmyard animal  
Animals must be dressed in a costume  
Ribbon awards only.

## **CLASS Y – Obstacle Course**

Animals will be led through an obstacle course by their handler  
Ribbon awards only.

## **Class Z – Grow the Show**

Entries will be on display all day

**Peoples' Choice Award**
